TREK A UNIQUE MOTORHOME

Trek motorhomes were manufactured by Safari starting in 1991. It seemed to be the rule then as now that the smaller the coach the poorer the quality. Treks have always been unique – a moderately sized, moderately priced, fully-equipped, premium quality motorhome. Treks are unbelievably roomy because of the “Electro-Majic” bed in the ceiling. With no bedroom, a 29 foot Trek has about the same useable room as a 38 foot traditional motorhome. This makes the Trek one of the most versatile coaches on the road.



Treks were manufactured by Safari from 1991 through 2001 and then by Monaco under the Safari brand through 2008. The 2016 Trek was briefly sold by the REV group..

RALLIES ARE WHERE THE FUN HAPPENS

Rallies are opportunities for fellow Trekkers to gather and share the fun of motorhome living. Rallies are held at camping resorts, state parks, and other venues in Oregon, Washington, British Columbia, and sometimes beyond.

It is the goal of NWTFC to have at least three rallies a year (one of which may be a pre-rally to an FMCA event). The objective is to spread rallies among spring, summer, and fall and distribute rallies among the geographic areas served by NWTFC.



Rallies generally consist of three nights of camping with potlucks, a meal out, a tour of someplace interesting, an RV seminar, and lots of fun and fellowship. NWTFC members are encouraged to volunteer to plan and lead rallies as wagon masters.
