Reports:

Income Statement by Sue Bjornson which was not repeated for the General Meeting. We have \$6781 in checking and \$1284 in savings for the web site.

Secretary's Report, Currently we have 81 members, 8 new members this year.

All the above reports were motioned to be approved with a positive vote.

National Director Al Zimmerman reminded us that FMCA has solicited a vote for a bylaw change that would include all self-contained recreational vehicles. He had copies of the voting form which can also be found on the FMCA website as well as the magazine. The emphasis was on having as many as possible votes on the matter.

He reminded us of the June 21-24, 2018 Rally in Coos Bay as well as the July 18-21 FMCA International Convention in Gillette Wyoming. There is still a possibility to meet up in Cody Wyoming at the Buffalo KOA and caravan together to the FMCA convention.

He noted that NWTFC is still looking at the possibility of both a Spring and Fall Rally.

Volunteers are being sought for both our own rallies and the FMCA NW Area rally.

Ron Mahugh reported on the August 9-13, 2018 Port Townsend Rally. There are 23 spots currently being held. Included in the program this year will be a CPR class plus a defibrillator demo.

Helen Anderson our current Rally Coordinator reminded us that she is to be replaced for 2018.

Al Zimmerman noted that Coos Bay needs volunteers for the store.

There is a rumor that FMCA may not provide the Assist Coverage for Motor Homes over 10 years of age. The answer is that FMCA may not have a driver for that vehicle but you can select your driver and expenses will be repaid.
