

Executive Board Meeting for NWTFC, August 2017

Those present were: Steve Weber-Plank, President, Paula Shull, Vice President, Al Zimmerman, FMCA representative, Mike Ashbridge, Alternate FMCA representative and Helen Anderson, Rally Co-ordinator. Absent were: David Pierce, Secretary, and Sue Bjornson, Treasurer.

The meeting was called to order by President Steve Weber-Plank who appointed Paula Shull Secretary pro-tem.

Officers' reports were called for. Al Zimmerman reminded us of the FMCA by-law change that refers to including all forms of RVs as eligible for membership in FMCA and the poor voter response to the request for ballots. To remedy that situation somewhat Al has printed ballots for us to vote during the membership meeting and they will be returned as a group.
