A Park Pass is required for camping at Spring Canyon. You need to display the pass while in the campground. A Park Pass includes one of the following: a single visit receipt, the Mt. Rainier Annual, Interagency Annual, Volunteer, Senior or Access passes. You can get a lifetime **Senior Pass** at

<http://www.nps.gov/findapark/passes.htm>.

The lifetime pass costs \$10. With this pass your camping fees are \$9 instead of \$18.

Reservations must be made soon so sign up early for whatever portion of the rally you would like to attend. Once the deadline has passed for registration you will need to make your own arrangements with the campgrounds listed on the second page of this flyer.



DIRECTIONS:

Lakeshore RV Park

619 W. Manson Hwy, Chelan, WA 98816

Take Hwy 97-A north out of Wenatchee all the way to Chelan; from downtown Chelan follow signs to SR 150 and Manson, proceeding about a half mile to the campground on the left.

Sun Lakes Resort

34228 Park Lake Rd NE, Coulee City, WA

From EAST on I-90 (from Seattle) take exit 151 (Hwy 283) through Ephrata to Soap Lake, then continue north on Hwy 17 to Sun Lakes-Dry Falls State Park.

From WEST on I-90 (from Spokane) take exit 179 (Hwy 17) to Soap Lake, then continue North to Sun Lakes-Dry Falls State Park.

If taking Hwy 2 from Spokane, continue through Coulee City and turn South at the Dry Falls junction (Hwy 2 & 17) to Sun Lakes-Dry Falls State Park.

Sun Lakes Resort is within Sun Lakes-Dry Falls State Park. Use State Park entrance, resort is on right at base of hill.

Spring Canyon (NPS)

Lake Roosevelt National Recreation Area)

From city of Grand Coulee drive 3 miles EAST on SR 174 to the campground, on the shores of Lake Roosevelt.
